
ORESUNDSKOLLEGIET WILL WITHIN A YEAR CONVERT FROM A SELF-GOVERNING INSTITUTION TO PUBLIC HOUSING



Build in 1974, much maintainance work has been done.

The dorm room doors no longer comply with the fire separation regulations and therefore they need to be replaced. All doors will be provided with electric locks, which generates a smaller additional cost when the doors are first installed.

It is no longer feasible to maintain water and drain installations, as cleaning and replacement is too expensive.

> The windows have been painted, however the wood cannot breathe through the paint. For that reason a replacement of the windows is necessary.

PLAN FOR UPCOMING RENOVATION

The plan, including a rent increase after the renovation, was passed at the Residents Meeting on June 6 th , 2018.

WHAT ARE THE

COMMUNE TO SUPPORT
LOANS FOR THE
RENOVATION?

Approximately 100 apartments will go to Copenhagen Commune and be occupied by students with special needs.

Øresundskollegiet converts from a self-governing institution to public housing under the housing organization PAB within a year.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR ME AS A TENANT?

- Within 1-2 years the renovation will start and it will be carried out in stages. You should expect noise. The rent will increase for each block once the block has been renovated. The increase will be given with 3 months notice. We are not able to inform of the specific increase at this point.
- Desing converted to a public housing department with PAB means that tenants at @resundskollegiet are able to apply internally for housing at PAB's more than 20 housing departments including more than 4000 apartments. The internal waiting list at @resundskollegiet will continue without change.



Øresundskollegiet will become a public housing department of PAB. This means that the dorm must select a department board and the current board of Directors with members appointed by the munici-pality and by the educa-tional institutions in Copenhagen will be closed. The department board at the dorm will be in charge of the resi-dents' meeting and the board will have limited jurisdiction and leeway. PAB's Board and Representatives will have the final decisionmaking authority accord-ing to the law and the department board will have the overall respon-sibility regarding future operation of the dorm.
