

New, temporary extra locks to be placed on doors to all apartments

New, temporary extra locks (Danalock) will be installed on the doors to all rooms as part of the major renovation so that workers can let themselves in to work without you having to give us an extra key.

What does this mean for you?

You will still use your own key to get in and out of the apartment. You should NOT use the new lock.

The extra lock will be installed on the interior side of your door and the worker unlocks it via an app on their mobile phone.

Safety in the new temporary locks:

The workers are only able to use the temporary lock between 8:00-17:00 on weekdays, which is when the renovations will occur.

The locks are coded so that only the specific workers that need to get into the apartment are able to unlock the door. This means, for example, that only the drainpipe workers can get in on the days when the drainpipes are being renovated in the apartment, etc.

There is also a tracking system in the temporary locks that will allow the administration, if the situation requires, to create a log of precisely which workers let themselves in and out of the apartment.

When will the new locks be installed?

The extra, temporary locks will be installed on the first day of each phase of the renovations, so that the workers can get into the apartment during the days/weeks under which the given phase of renovation takes place.

The renovation work is divided into three different phases/contracts and each contractor will install a temporary lock and remove it again when their work or the given phase of renovation has been completed.

Example: When the first phase (renovation of the drainpipes) begins, the drainpipe workers will install a temporary lock on the door. When the renovation of the drainpipes is completed, the drainpipe workers will remove the locks again.

When the next phase (interior improvements) begins, the relevant workers will install a temporary lock on their first day of work and remove it again when their phase of the renovation is complete, and so on...

Danalock is used on many construction sites in Denmark and provides a good level of safety for the residents, as the construction project can always get access to all of the data regarding who has been in which apartment and when. Please note that only the administration has access to this data.
